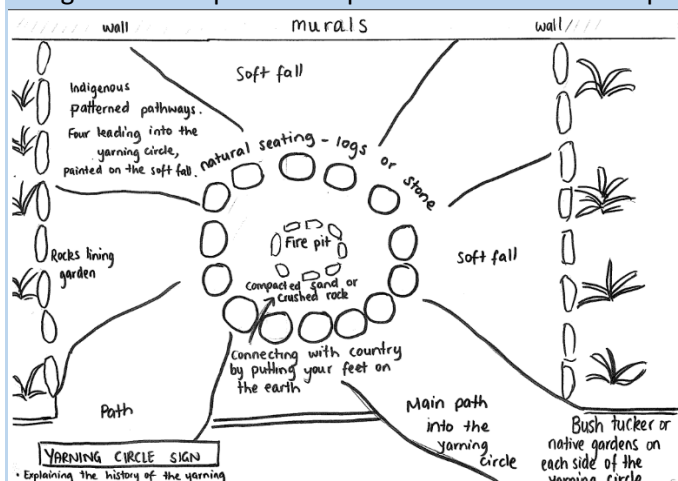
Principal's Message
